

# Investigation Leads to Six Arrests in B&E – Thefts

A rapidly evolving, multi-jurisdiction investigation into a series of housebreaks in town led to the arrest of six individuals, and the recovery of a stolen firearm. Scituate Detectives started the investigation into the breaks, which led them to Steven Skane, age 18, of Scituate. Skane is alleged to have stolen the guns, a rifle and a handgun, during the breaks and sold them to John Canavan, age 21, of Cohasset. Canavan is alleged to have, in turn, sold the rifle to 20 year-old Isiah and 19 year-old Jordan Brady of Scituate.

Skane and another man, Rafael A. Claudio were stopped in the Village Market parking lot by undercover and uniformed officers and after a brief foot chase and scuffle the two were arrested. The detectives also recovered heroin as a result of the stop.

The rifle was recovered in woods off of Tilden Road. The handgun has not yet been recovered, but 21 year-old Kyle P. Foster of Kingston was arrested by Kingston Police on numerous charges, and is believed to have taken possession of the stolen pistol.

The charges against the various individuals are as follows:

- POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ‘CLASS A’
- FIREARM, CARRY WITHOUT LICENSE
- B&E BUILDING DAYTIME FOR FELONY (3 Counts)
- FIREARM, LARCENY OF (2 Counts)
- LARCENY FROM BUILDING (2 Counts)

## **RAFAEL A. CLAUDIO, AGE 33 of 153 JERICHO ROAD, SCITUATE**

- POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE (CLASS ‘A’ –SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE)
- RESISTING ARREST

## **ISIAH J. BRADY, AGE 20 of 14 EDGAR ROAD, SCITUATE**

- RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY OVER \$250

## **JORDAN BRADY, AGE 19 of 14 EDGAR ROAD, SCITUATE**

- RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY OVER \$250

## **JOHN CANAVAN, AGE 21 of 17 CHURCH STREET< COHASSET**

- RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY OVER \$250

## **KYLE P. FOSTER, AGE 21, of 8 BRAINTREE AVENUE IN KINGSTON**

- UNLICENSED POSSESSION OF A LARGE-CAPACITY FIREARM
- UNLICENSED POSSESSION OF AMMUNITION
- UNLICENSED POSSESSION OF A LARGE CAPACITY FEEDING DEVICE OR MAGAZINE
- RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY OVER \$250
- DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE (CLASS ‘B’)
- POSS. WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE (CLASS B)

The investigation is continuing and further arrests are anticipated.
